### **Foreigner**

#### To Check-in, require the presentation of







- 1.Health certificate certifying that the passengers have no evidence of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)", issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel.
- 2. Health insurance/health insurance policy that shows minimum medical coverage of 100,000 USD in Thailand and covers the Covid-19 Disease.

#### **Thai**

#### To Check-in, require the presentation of







- 1. Health certificate confirming that the passenger is fit to fly.
- 2. Letter issued by Royal Thai Embassy, Royal Thai Consulate-General or Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Kingdom of Thailand certifying that the passenger is Thai National returning to Thailand.

## To enter Thailand, present to the communicable disease control official:







1.Completed T.8 Form or "AOT Airport of Thailand" Application.

2. Subject to isolation, quarantine, under observation, or any other measures for the prevention and control of communicable diseases.
