

For non-Thai nationals who have the Certificate of Residence

While Thailand still puts in place travel restriction, non-Thai nationals who **have the Certificate of Residence and valid re-entry permit** can apply for the Certificate of Entry.

Required documents, which must be registered online to coethailand.mfa.go.th/

1. Your passport copy
2. A copy of the Certificate of Residence
3. A copy of valid re-entry permit
4. Letter from health insurance policy which covers COVID related medical treatment and coverage of no less than 100,000 USD, covering the whole intended period of stay. In case that the applicant intends to stay in the Kingdom for more than one year, the health insurance should cover at least the period of one year.

5. A copy of a hotel booking for **Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ)** at one of the hotels approved by the Thai authorities * (www.hsscovid.com)
6. Flight Ticket

What you need to prepare hard copy to present at airlines check-in counter and upon arrival at the immigration in Thailand:

1. The Certificate of Entry
2. Fit to Fly health certificate, issued within 72 hours before departure this is a statement by a doctor that you are free from symptoms and fit to fly (must be separate from COVID test)
3. Medical certificate with a **laboratory result** using RT-PCR test indicating that COVID -19 is not detected. Such COVID-19 test **result** must be **issued no more than 72 hours before departure**
4. Copy of your insurance policy which covers COVID and no less than 100,000 USD
5. Copy of your confirmed booking at an ASQ hotel
6. T.8 form
